- PLEASE READ THIS FIRST - VERY IMPORTANT - EVENT VENUE ACCESS

THERE WILL BE NO PARKING AVAILABLE FOR TEAMS, INDIVIDUALS OR SUPPORTERS FOR EVENT PURPOSES WITHIN THE MAIN AGRODOME TOURISM SITE. ANYONE PARKING IN HERE RISKS HAVING THEIR VEHICLE TOWED.

With upwards of 1,000 competitors and 2,000 supporters now expected, it is vital that teams, individuals and supporters understand the following important parking information that follows as there will be a high volume of traffic accessing the venue throughout the event.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS: School vans and buses need to park through Gate 8 off Western Road (this is just past the main Agrodome entrance on the right hand side if coming off SH5 or on the left hand side if coming up Western Road from Ngongataha). This entrance will be sign posted and marshalled by event staff. From this parking area the entrance to the A&P Oval is a short walk directly across the







bridge. NOTE: IF GATE 8 PARKING REACHES CAPACITY OVERFLOW WILL BE INTO GATE 5 OFF WESTERN ROAD AS BELOW OR ON THE SIDE OF WESTERN ROAD TOWARDS NGONGATAHA.

Parking for other vehicles will be through Gate 5 in the paddocks on the northern side of Western Road (this is on the left hand side opposite the main Agrodome entrance if coming off SH5 or on the right hand side past Gate 8 if coming up Western Road from Ngongataha). This entrance will be sign posted and marshalled by event staff. From this parking area, the entrance to the A&P Oval is a short walk across Western Road at the designated crossing point and into Agrodome on a coned and sign posted pedestrian lane on the left hand side, across a bridge, then left through the shearing sheds and wood chopping arena to the A&P Oval. FOR SAFETY REASONS - WE ASK THAT ALL PEOPLE USING THE GATE 5 PARKING AREA WALK ON THE MARKED & CONED PATHWAY ON THE LEFT HAND SIDE INTO AGRODOME NOT ALONG WESTERN ROAD THROUGH GATE 8.
