New Zealand Secondary Schools Athletics Association offers the opportunity for any school to put forward an **Expression of Interest** [EOI] if their school would be interested in competing at this event in 2023.

**Key Need to Know Information:**

- World Schools Championships [WSC] are events characterized by a balanced program between sport and educational content, fair play, healthy lifestyle, respect and inclusion.

- 2023 WSC - Athletics Provisional Program Dates:

18-19 June Arrival of Delegations  
20 June Training  
21 June Opening Ceremony, Competition  
22 June Competition  
23 June Friendship Relay, Nations Night  
24 June Cultural Day, Farwell Function  
25-26 June Departure

- Age Category: U18 students born 2005-2006-2007

- Events:

**Boys:**

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 100m H, 300m Hurdles, 1000m Medley Relay (100, 200, 300m, 400)  
High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot, Discus, Javelin

**Girls:**

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 100m H, 300m Hurdles, 1000m Medley Relay (100, 200, 300m, 400)  
High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot, Discus, Javelin

**Each athlete is allowed to compete in two events**, plus the relay in the following combinations: 1race and 1jump, 1race and 1throw, 1jump and 1throw.  
A team is not allowed to enter more than 3 athletes in one event.

- Team format:

School Teams: Teams formed by athletes enrolled full time in the same school in the same country they represent.

Selected Teams: Teams formed by athletes that can be enrolled in different schools in the same country which they represent. – selected by NZSSAA.

- Each Country (Delegation) can enter a minimum of one of each team, or a maximum of:  
3 x School Boys teams (*of 6 athletes*)  
3 x School Girls teams (*of 6 athletes*)  
1 x Country Selected Boys team (*NZSS team of 6*)  
1 x Country Selected Girls team (*NZSS team of 6*)

- Accommodation and meals are provided as part of the package, teams staying in hostels within walking distance to the championships.

- Closing of Registration phase 1:

10 December 2022 Deposit payment (Euro 100 per participant)  
11 December 2022 Registration phase 2  
19 March 2023 Registrations close

Approximate Costs

With international travel expensive, the approximate cost could be between \$6,000.00 and \$8,000 per athlete.

Expressions of Interest are required to be in writing to the President of NZSSAA, Tony Rogers by **Friday 1st December 2022** with an indicative list of possible team members and approximate performances levels and expected events.
