



We're excited to announce that we will have an Olympic gold medalist joining our super star sporting panel as well as some other outstanding sporting legends from the Stars Netball Team and the New Zealand Black Sticks Hockey Team.



Ellesse Andrews - Olympic NZ Track Sprint Cyclist

Ellesse is a New Zealand Track Sprint cyclist. She represented New Zealand at the 2018 Commonwealth Games and the 2020 Summer Olympics, where she gained a silver medal in the keirin. At the 2024 Summer Olympics, she earned two gold medals for winning the keirin and sprint, as well as a silver medal in the team sprint.



Kate Burley - Stars ANZ Premiership Netball

Kate started playing netball in primary school, at the age of 6 and in 2025 will be going into her 9th year in the ANZ Premiership playing professionally. She plays GK and GD and has played for the Stars, Northern Mystics and the Southern Steel. Her favourite thing about playing netball are the friendships that she has made over the years! And her highlight was winning the ANZ with the Mystics and being named in the Silver Ferns squad last year!



Samantha Child -NZ Hockey Player

Sam is the 3rd most capped Women's Black Stick, having retired in 2024 after playing 277 games for New Zealand. She played at the London (2012, 4th place), Rio (2016, 4th place) and Tokyo (2021, 8th place) and won a Gold Medal at the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games and a Bronze Medal at the 2014 Glasgow Commonwealth Games.

AMAKI MAKAURAU CULTURE OF

Tāmaki Makaurau lwi

Nau mai, haere mai ki Tāmaki Makaurau – Welcome to Auckland!

Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland has been a centre of connection, commerce, and culture for over a millennium. The region is rich, with 19 lwi Mana Whenua recognised as the original local authorities. Now home to the largest urban Māori population in the world, Tāmaki Makaurau brings together Māori from all parts of Aotearoa, alongside diverse communities drawn from the Asia-Pacific and beyond.

Te Ao Māori in Sport and Cultural Wellbeing

Tāmaki Makaurau is a centre for both traditional and contemporary Māori sport. Activities such as kī-o-rahi (a traditional ball game), waka ama (outrigger canoes) and mau rākau (Māori martial arts and combat) are thriving, and there is strong Māori participation in mainstream sports.

Māori rangatahi (aged 5–17) have the highest rates of competitive physical activity participation in Aotearoa. Sport plays a powerful role in strengthening hauora (holistic health and wellbeing), whanaungatanga (relationships and kinship ties), and confidence in te ao Māori (the Māori world view).
