Boys

Matthew Brown (Nelson College for Boys) ran 21.41s in the 200m. Although wind assistance was 2.1ms it was just 0.01s away from the NZSS Record.

Junior Maninoa (Kelston Boys' High School) through 17.35m in the Shot Put. This is the best performance for at least 3 years and is 24cm away from the record. He also threw the discus 52.88m which also has not been bettered in the last three years.

Hayden McLaren (Shirley Boys' High School) was a comfortable winner in the 3000m in 8 minutes 37.52s a time that has not been bettered for at least 3 years.

Shafat Salad (Fairfield College) ran 19:08.00s in the 6000m Boys Road Race gaining him the Road Race award.

Girls

Amanda Gorst (Havelock North High School) broke the record for the 2000m Walk (set in 1990) by 14s to record a time of 9 minutes 10s. Most winners of this event do not go under 10 minutes.

Jessica Penney (Wellington Girls' College) jumped 6.01m in the Long Jump which is just 3cm short of the record.

Nneka Okpala (Diocesan School for Girls) set a record in the Triple Jump by recording 12.13 and beating the old record by 3cm.

Kate Mitchell (Rangitoto College) ran 14:47.00s in the 4000m Girls Road Race also gained the Road Race award.
