Organisation of the New Balance 2005 Championships is underway. The Local Organizing Committee comprises representatives of College Sport Auckland, Auckland Secondary Schools Athletics, and Athletics Auckland. Ericsson Stadium is an all-weather eight-lane track located in Central Auckland and is home base to the Warriors league team and was where the 1990 Commonwealth Games were held.

Road Race

This year as with Waikato last year and following the policy which our Association has introduced at cross country nationals there will be separate races for Year 9 athletes with medals for individual places and for teams both three and six person. The event will be held on Sunday morning 5th December.

The course for the road race is in the process of being approved by the council. We are planning to run the event on Dunkirk and Riverside Rd's in Panmure. (Approximately 15 minutes from the stadium).

The first race will commence at the 7.30am. The order of events will be confirmed in the next newsletter when the venue is confirmed.

Entries

Entry details will be released with the second posting, due to be distributed on 9th September. All entries must be entered on the NZSSAA website nzssaa.org.nz on or before 25th November.

Please diary your own school entry date much earlier than this date NOW, so that you don't have to pay a late entry fee.

The website will be open for entries from the 25th of October. Faxed or telephone entries **will not be accepted**. Entry fees will also be collected on the website. Instructions for this process will be on the website. Entries will not be posted on the website until receipt of payment from schools.

Late entries, together with an additional late fee of \$10 per athlete up to \$100 per school will be accepted until 2 December. After this date no further entries will be accepted. No late fee. No entry. This policy is now in its fifth year of operation, and has the full support of the Executive. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. Late entries names will probably not appear in the programme.

Entry Fees

The entry fees (as set by the NZSSAA Executive) (GST inclusive) payable per athlete (excluding relays) for Track & Field and/or Road Race are:

\$10.00 one or two events (including the road race)

\$15.00 three or more events

\$10.00 for athletes competing only in the relay

Scratchings

Scratchings for single events must be done on the website by **Wednesday 7th December**. After that date, any scratchings received will be considered as scratchings from all events.

This procedure was introduced in 1997 and proved highly successful. It has the support of the Executive and will be strictly enforced.

Travel

To obtain the cheapest air fares early planning and booking is required.

School Numbers

The national secondary school 4 letter code will be used for identification (refer to the NZ Secondary Schools Sports Council Sports Directory 2005). All athletes will be provided with their individual number to be worn during competition. Walkers will be issued with two numbers, to be worn on the front and back of their singlet.

Spikes & Blocks; Field Equipment

Spikes 6mm for track

9mm for high jump and javelin

Only the starting blocks provided may be used. The use of starting blocks will be compulsory for all track events up to and including 400m.

Personal throwing implements may be used provided they have been checked by the Equipment Officer and the implement items then become available for use by all other competitors. Check in time for weighting of implements will be confirmed in a later newsletter.

Championship T-Shirts

Souvenir t-shirts will be available for purchase. A picture of the t-shirt design will be included in the next posting. Orders will be handled through the website.
