## **Age Groups**

Junior Under 16 years on 31 December 2006 Senior Under 19½ years on 31 December 2006

Note: Competition is only open to students currently enrolled in Years 9 plus and attending an affiliated

school.

Year 9 For the Road Race only, there is a Year 9 age grade. Competitors must be a Year 9

student and under 15 years on 31 December 2006.

#### **Road Race**

The event will be held on Sunday morning 10 December. The course for the Road Race is in the Bottle Lake Forest Park approximately 3km from the stadium. The course on Landfill Ave is that which will be used for the Athletics New Zealand Road Championships in October. Visit

## **Entries**

Entry details will be released with the second Newsletter, due to be published 18 September. All entries must be entered on the NZSSAA website <a href="www.nzssaa.org.nz">www.nzssaa.org.nz</a> on or before 4 December. Please diary your own school entry date much earlier than this date, as that date would be far too late to be making travel or accommodation arrangements.

The website will be open for entries from 25 October. Faxed or telephone entries will not be accepted.

Entry fees will also be collected on the website. Instructions for this process will be on the website. Entries will close Monday 4 December, after this date no further entries will be accepted. As there is no late entry period there will be no late entry fees.

## **Entry Fees**

A proposal to increase the entry fees is currently before the NZSSAA Executive. If an increase is ratified it will be notified at the time of Newsletter Two.

The **current** entry fees (G.S.T. inclusive) payable per athlete (excluding relays) for Track & Field and/or Road Race are:

\$10.00 one or two events (including the Road Race)

\$15.00 three or more events

\$10.00 for athletes competing only in the relays

# **Scratchings**

Scratchings for single events must be done on the website by **Wednesday 6 December**. After that date, only scratchings from **all** events will be accepted at the Managers' Meeting on the forms provided.

All athletes will be provided with their individual number to be worn during competition. Walkers will be issued with two numbers, to be worn on the front and back of their singlet.

# Spikes & Blocks; Field Equipment

Spikes: 6mm for track

9mm for high jump and javelin

Only the starting blocks provided may be used. The use of starting blocks will be compulsory for all track events up to and including 400m.

Personal throwing implements may be used provided they have been checked by the Equipment Officer, and the implement items then become available for use by all other competitors. Check in time for weighing of implements will be confirmed in a later newsletter.
