COLLECTION OF SCHOOL PACKS / T-SHIRT PACKS / AGM

School Packs (competition numbers, programmes, passes etc) and T-Shirt packs, will be available at Newtown Park from Friday, 3.30pm – 5.45pm and at the gate on Saturday, 8am – 10am.

Only the designated team manager will be able to uplift the packs. There will be an opportunity on the Friday to speak to the Technical Information people to deal with concerns managers may have. **There will be one free manager/helper ticket for every ten athletes.**

The NZSSAA AGM will begin at the conclusion of the Managers Meeting on Friday 9 December at Newtown Park and we urge you to attend.

LATE SCRATCHINGS

These must be made with explanation at the Managers Meeting. Replacements are only permitted in relays and to retain a road team.

MEDAL ENGRAVING

There will be an engraver on site to engrave the medals at the athlete's expense. The cost will be \$10 per medal.

NO TEAM TENTS POSSIBLE

Because of the limited space at Newtown Park there will be no school tents allowed on the top ground or surrounding areas.

PARKING

The gate at the zoo end of the Stadium will be closed but can be used as a drop off area. Parking beside the stadium will be available for AWD athletes and officials only. Parking will be available in the car parks behind the top field which are accessed off Russell Tce.
