

Para-Athletes (Athletes with Physical, Visual and Intellectual Impairments)
Classification
NZ Secondary Schools Athletics Championships
Hamilton 7th-8th December 2013

Athletes with Physical, Visual and Intellectual Impairments competing at the 2013 NZ Secondary Schools Athletics Championships in Hamilton 7th – 8th December **are required** to have a Provisional or National Classification.

Classification is the process whereby athletes are grouped together according to their impairment and reflected activity limitation. Classification ensures that athletes meet impairment eligibility and that competition is fair and equitable.

Athletes who **do not have** a Provisional or National Classification will need to have completed one of the Provisional Forms attached, whichever is the most appropriate.

Please find attached the Provisional Forms for Physical, Visual and Intellectual Impairment.

This form needs to be forwarded to with their event entry or sent to classification@paralympics.org.nz **as soon as possible and no later than November 22nd.**

Para-Athletes with a **Physical Impairment only**, who do not have a National Classification, are requested to be available in Hamilton from the morning of **Friday 6th December** when you will be scheduled to attend a Classification Session.
