TIMELINE:

- 23 Nov, 12noon - orders for Merchandise close
- 27 Nov - individual scratchings close
- 29 Nov, 2pm - 5pm - Track open for inspection. Set-up will still be underway so there will be some restrictions to the track etc.
- 30 Nov, 10am - School Tent setup on designated area on warm-up ground. For schools that have pre-booked sites.
- 30 Nov, 10am - Managers packs/Merchandise collection - L1 Room (enter back stairs of the Grandstand). Road Race Timing Transponders will be available for collection from 2pm on Friday from L1 Room, due to a delay in the delivery of these.
- 30 Nov, 11am - Managers Meeting/NZSSAA AGM - L2 Room overlooking the grandstand/track (enter back stairs of the Grandstand or via Grandstand)
- 30 Nov - 2 December, Track and Field Championships at the Caledonian
- 2 Dec - Road Race Championships at Forsyth Barr Stadium

EVENT PARKING/TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT:

See attached the venue map which outlines some on field event parking. This will be in place from 10am Friday 30 Nov through to Sunday 2 Dec. Street parking is also available in this area.

Please note: Due to the large amount of rain/flooding Otago has experienced this week there is some uncertainty around the on-field parking. Should this become unavailable you will be notified asap.

Please note the bottom end of Logan Park Drive will be closed to all traffic on Saturday and Sunday. Vehicles will need to exit Logan Park Drive via the sports fields onto Harbour Terrace during this time. On Friday 30 Nov a designated 'drop-off' zone will be in place behind the Caledonia for athlete/tent drop offs.

MANAGERS PACKS/PASSES/PROGRAMMES:

Managers Packs are available for collection from 10am Friday 30 Nov from the L1 Room of the Grandstand at the Cale (enter from the back stairs behind the grandstand).

Managers Passes: These will be allocated based on your team numbers and will be included in your managers packs. *Access through the gates to the Cale will be granted on an honesty bases on the Friday, so if you are the manager coming to collect the pack then please advise the gate keepers of this and they will let you through to collect the pack.*

ALL spectators and coaches etc. that do not have a pass given to them by the manager will need to pay the small gate fee.

Programmes will also be allocated and included in the managers pack based on your entry numbers. If you have additional coaches etc. needing a programme, they will need to purchase one either from the gate or from the info desk located at the centre of the grandstand track side.

GATE CHARGE / PROGRAMME SALES

Eftpos and cash sales will be available for both ticket and programme sales.

- Gate fees for this year's event is as follows:
 - 1-day pass - \$5 Child, \$10 Adult, \$20 Family
 - 3-day pass - \$10 Child, \$20 Adult, \$40 Family

 - Main Programme - \$5
 - Daily inserts – free if you show main programme, otherwise \$2 per insert
