## 26 July 2019

Welcome to the first newsletter for the 2019 New Zealand Secondary Schools Track, Field and Road Championships.

The Local Organising Committee (LOC) wish to confirm that the NZSS Track & Field champs are to be held over two and a half days, commencing on **Friday 6 December 2019 at 1:00 pm** at **Newtown Park, Athletics Track, Wellington.** 

The managers meeting for those who are able to be there will begin at **11:00 am** with the NZSSAA AGM to follow and completed by 12.30 pm.

### AGE GROUPS

- All athletes must have turned 13 prior to 31 December 2019
- Junior Under 16 as at 31 December 2019 (born on or after 1 January 2004)
- Senior Under 20 as at 31 December 2019 (born between 1 January 2000 and 31 December 2003)
- Year 9 Road Race only Runners must be in Year 9 and under 15 as at 31 December 2019 (born on or after 1 January 2005). A runner can compete in the Year 9 race once only.
- Para Athletes Junior Under 17 (born on or after 1 January 2003). Senior as above except the senior age for ORS funded students is under 22 on 31 December 2019. Contact oe@nzssaa.org.nz to enter over 20 years of age athletes.

## ENTRIES

All entries must be made online on the NZSSAA website **on or before 22 November 2019.** The website will be **open for entries from 14 October 2019 and will close on 22 November 2019 at midnight**. Details of how to do this will come in a separate document closer to the opening of entries.

#### AFFILIATION

The Association collects school affiliation fees with entries. Schools that did not have competitors at the Cross-Country Championships in Timaru will have the \$55.00 affiliation fee added to their entries invoice.

## **ENTRY FEES**

The entry fees payable per athlete for track and field and/or road race are as follows:

- \$22.00 one or two events (including the road race)
- \$30.00 three or more events
- \$10.00 relay only competitors

#### **ROAD RACE**

The Road Race venue will be held at the **NZCIS Course, Somme Rd, Upper Hutt**. We will provide further information as soon as we have the course confirmed.

#### TRACK VENUE

Newtown Park Athletic Stadium can seat approximately 5,000 people. Approximately 1,800 in the stand and the rest on the grassed areas surrounding the rest of the track. The track itself is made of Rekortan texture and has the reputation of being fast.

There will be some room for schools to bring small shelters and tents to be placed on the uneven grass embankment around the track.

There will also be space available to put up some shading on the northern end road behind the fence around the track.

The track will be open on the **Thursday – 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019 from 2.00 to 5.00pm** for light practice/training but as we are setting up the venue, this may restrict some areas and we thank you for your cooperation (e.g. throwing circles marked, etc.)

## EQUIPMENT

Starting blocks and throwing implements are provided. If you wish to use your own implement this will be required to be measured and weighed and if passed, will be held in the equipment storeroom and brought out at competition time. The times to do this will be provided closer to the event. Pole vault poles are usually an athlete's responsibility but if there is difficulty in transporting them, we may be able to provide some additional poles.
