Principals Authority

To gain access to the entry forms in your school's portal, the person responsible will need to type in the **User Name** and then the **Password** for your school/kura. These must be kept secure. By passing this information to that person we will deem that the Principal has given their authority to make the entries from their school/kura and confirms the athletes meet all eligibility requirements.

ENTRY INFORMATION

All runners must have turned 13 prior to 31st December 2025.

Year 9: Athletes must be in Year 9 and under age 15 as at 31st December 2025 (born on or after 1st January 2011). An athlete may compete in the Year 9 race only once.

Junior: Athletes must be under age 16 as at 31st December 2025 (born on or after 1st January 2011).

Senior: Athletes must be under age 20 as at 31st December 2025 (born between 1st January 2006 and 31st December 2009).

Para: As for Year 9 (Road Race only), Junior and Senior grades except ORS funded athletes can be Under age 22 as at 31st December 2025 (born on or after 1 January 2004).

Participation and Affiliation

- ✓ Participation in these Championships is open to any student Year 9 or above, who attends a New Zealand Secondary School.
- ✓ Home School athletes affiliated to the Home Educators Student Sports Association (HESSA) will be eligible for 2025.
- ✓ Year 7 and 8 students are not eligible to compete.
- ✓ International athletes are also welcome to enter and compete, but they must be attending a secondary school in their home country. Athletes from other countries who are attending schools in New Zealand can only compete for their New Zealand school.
 - "Cook Islands and Niue Athletes"
 Athletes from the Cook Islands and Niue will be considered as international or visiting athletes if they are enrolled and attend school in the Cook Islands or Niue. Any such athlete that is attending a NZ school will be classified as domestic student and such athletes enrolled in NZ School must be entered by their school

Affiliation with New Zealand Secondary Schools Athletic Association is invoiced as part of the entry process for the Championships.

Entry Procedures for Team Managers/Sports Coordinators

The entry procedures for Team Managers and Sports Coordinators are as follows:

- ENTRIES OPEN online on Monday 13th October 2025
- ENTRIES CLOSE online at midnight on Monday 17th November 2025.

Please **DO NOT be LATE** with your entries. From 17th November, any additional entries are added only with the approval of the online entries' administrator.

LATE ENTRIES

Any late entries are to be emailed to <u>oe@nzssaa.org.nz</u> and there will be an additional charge **of \$10.00 per entry**

To enter your school's athletes, go to the NZSSAA website (www.nzssaa.org.nz) and click on online entries (http://entries.co.nz/o/nzsstfrr2025/)

A login prompt will be presented to your browser. Enter your assigned username and password to proceed into the system. Please fill in your school information first before completing your entries. If you do not have your school's username and password, check with your Principal who should be holding a copy. If you still cannot access the site, then email (oe@nzssaa.org.nz) for the information.

FEES

NZSSAA Affiliation Fee: The affiliation fee to NZSSAA is \$55.00 (including GST) per school payable with online entries.

Entry Fees: The entry fee is \$30.00 (including GST) per athlete for 1-2 events, \$40.00 for 3 or more events, \$15.00 for relays only.

Your entries are complete when you have chosen the payment option, produced an invoice and paid. There is one option for payment only:

• Direct crediting the NZSSAA bank account: 12-3150-0174691-00.

When payment has been received and receipted, a copy of the school's receipt is available in the payment section of online entries to print off if required.

Please note: Additional entries can be added until entries close even though you may have already generated an invoice or paid. Enter your additional athletes and pay for them accordingly. Athlete entries will appear in the public Received Entries List but will show as unpaid until payment has been receipted. Entry enquiries are to be by email only to oe@nzssaa.org.nz
