Accommodation

No accommodation or billeting is being organised by the Organising Committee. We regret that some schools have had problems finding accommodation in the city and while it is likely that many vacancies will occur close to the event it does not help schools who wish to finalise their arrangements. It should, in addition be noted that Palmerston North is less than one hour's drive from Wanganui and Marton is only 30 minutes away.

The course will be run on the Collegiate School grounds utilising the undulating small golf course at the back of the School. The main circuit is 1400m and there is excellent viewing of just about the whole race.

4000 metres races (Senior Girls, Junior U16 Boys)

Start to golf course lap 470m

Two short laps 1680m One full lap 1400m Course to finish 460m

Total - 4010m

6000 metres races (Senior Boys) Start to golf course lap 470m One short lap 840m Three full laps 4200m Golf course to finish 460m

Age Groups

Year 9 Girls/Boys is for Year 9 students only. All must be under 15 as at 31 December 2005. An athlete can only run in the Year 9 race once.

Junior Girls/Boys: Under 16 as at 31 December 2005 Senior Girls/Boys: Under 19.5 as at 31 December 2005

Team Size

Schools with three to five finishers in any event will automatically be entered in the three person to score teams competition.

Schools with six or more finishers in any event will automatically be entered in both the three person to score and the six person to score events.

Medals will be awarded to all scoring members in the leading three teams in both the three and six to score events.

Participation and Affiliation to NZSSAA

Participation in these Championships is open to any student Year 9 or higher who attends a New Zealand Secondary School that holds current affiliation with the New Zealand Secondary Schools Athletic Association. (Year 7 and 8 students are not eligible to compete under any circumstances).

On the front, all the competing schools appear with a over-printed design. A sample will be posted on the website next week along with a t-shirt order form.
