The Mount Cook Games Cross-country for NZ Secondary Schools 1982
Competitors for the Ninth Cross-country Championships were faced with perfect conditions and excellent courses in Oamaru, the most southerly venue for any event conducted for the NZ.S.S.A.A.

Fields for the four races were similar in size to those at previous championships and provided competition of a high standard yet again. Interest in the performance of the top individuals is always high but a feature of cross-country championships is the enthusiasm generated by the teams' races. A particularly pleasing feature of the teams' races this year was that more schools were able to provide teams for one of the senior boys teams races.

The experiment of conducting two teams races for senior boys, within the same event, saw more teams in the three man event than in the five man event of previous years. Meanwhile those schools which have traditionally dominated the senior grade by virtue of their depth and keen interest were able to compete in the six man race too. While the same schools placed in both teams races this year (in different order), a close examination of the results indicates that this may not always be the case and that this experiment is worth a further trial. (For those interested in what might have happened had no changes been made, it is worth noting that the team with the lowest five man total this year scored the lowest, the best, total in the history of the race - by some twenty points. While that is disappointing for the school concerned because it did not win a team title this time, the fact that more schools were involved is a worthwhile development).

In the tradition established at previous cross-country championships this was a happy and enjoyable occasion well supported by the local schools and community.

Oamaru with its far and testing course (excellent for spectators too) the fine day, pleasant social function and top organisation provided the highlight of the cross-country season for the majority of those there.

It is on behalf of those who enjoyed that day that I offer a warm thank you to Oamaru, the organising committee, and, in particular Brother Lauren and Dave Mellish for their leadership and efforts.

For the NZ.S.S.A.A., the Mount Cook Line, sponsors of this meeting and eleven hundred competitors - Thank you, Oamaru.
