> the South Island Secondary School Athletics Championships be amended to
> agree with Athletics New Zealand standards.

- > 2. That the boys U15 hurdles distance be changed to 110m.
- > 3. That the boys U14 hurdles distance be changed to 100m.
- > 4. That the girls U16 hurdles distance be changed to 100m.
- > 5. That the girls U15 hurdles distance be changed to 100m.
- > 6. That the girls U14 hurdles distance be changed to 80m.
- > 7. That the boys U19 shot be changed to 6kg.

- > 8. That the boys U14 shot be changed to 5kg.
- > 9. That the girls U16 shot be changed to 4kg.
- > 10. That the girls U15 shot be changed to 4kg.
- > 11. That the boys U19 discus be changed to 1.75kg.
- > 12. That the boys U16 discus be changed to 1.5kg.
- > 13. That the boys U15 discus be changed to 1.5kg.
- > 14. That the boys U14 discus be changed to 1.25kg.
- > 15. That the boys U19 javelin be changed to 800g.
